ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO TERMINATE PROCEEDINGS

The EBDC/ETU Task Force, representing certain registrants of EBDCs, submitted to the EPA a petition to modify the applicable order upon settlement of the Notice of Intent to Cancel pesticide registrations. The modification sought was to reduce the Pre-Harvest Interval for EBDC fungicides on potatoes to three days nationwide. The Natural Resources Defense Council submitted a request for hearing on the petition, opposing the proposed modification. The National Potato Council was granted leave to intervene in this proceeding. The parties filed several motions, all of which were ruled upon.

On November 5, 2008, the EBDC/ETU Task Force filed a Motion to Terminate Proceeding, stating that it has withdrawn its applications for amendments and associated petition that were the basis for this proceeding. Counsel for the EBDC/ETU Task Force states that all parties to this matter have consented to the Motion.

The parties having consented to the Motion and the basis for this proceeding having been resolved, this proceeding before the undersigned is hereby deemed **TERMINATED** and **CLOSED** as of this date.
