

TRAINING VIDEOS – PRETREATMENT

California State University, Sacramento, under a grant from USEPA Office of Wastewater Management, is offering five training videos for Pretreatment Facility Inspectors. This video training program provides an excellent introduction to the knowledge, skills, and abilities needed by new inspectors to effectively perform their jobs. Current inspectors will find helpful ideas for improving their performance.

The videos are approximately 30 minutes long and cover the following topics:

- Meeting The Goal Together (pretreatment facility; the inspection program; responsibilities of inspectors/administrators; protection of the environment; ethical performance)
- Taking A Closer Look (how to conduct an inspection; scheduling; entering an industry for inspection; level of inspection; after the walk-through; report writing)
- Starting At The Source (how to inspect a metal-finishing industry; on-site industrial inspections; pollution prevention; data management)
- Taking Up A Collection (reasons for sampling; preparation for sampling; proper sample collection; handling/transporting samples; chain of custody)
- Going With The Flow (sampling and flow monitoring; instrumentation; automatic samplers)

The videos will enhance the training provided by the training manual on Pretreatment Facility Inspection.

TRAINING VIDEOS – COLLECTION SYSTEM OPERATOR

California State University, Sacramento, under a grant from USEPA Office of Wastewater Management, is offering six training videos. The six videos illustrate how to safely and properly operate and maintain both separate and combined sanitary sewer collection systems.

The videos cover the following topics:

- Guardians of the Health (importance of operators, inspections, and testing)
- TV Stars (closed circuit television inspection)

- Pipe Detectives (pipeline cleaning and maintenance methods)
- Way Makers (pipeline cleaning and chemical control)
- Flow Movers (operation of wastewater lift stations)
- Motor Specialists (maintenance of wastewater lift stations).

The videos show actual crews in the field demonstrating proper safe procedures to effectively use equipment; supervisors describe the activities of the crews. The comedian is used to demonstrate how to “not” do the job and to provide entertaining breaks in each training video. The videos can be used alone or with the Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Collection Systems training manual.
