

Population for Storm Water Entities as Defined by the 2000 Census

Wyoming

This document contains calculations for populations within an Urbanized Areas (UA) as designated by the US Census Bureau for the state of Wyoming. Population is calculated for each portion of either an incorporated place or a county within an UA and is based on the population values provided by the 2000 US Census Tiger data. In addition, a table is included that provides a list of places that have a population greater than 10,000 people and a population density of 1,000 people per square mile that are not located in an UA. This data was obtained from the US Census website.

* The population calculation for this area provides the population within the UA that is not located within an incorporated place. An incorporated place is created to provide governmental functions for a concentration of people. For example, a city or municipality is an example of an incorporated place.
