1. The Section L clause entitled "PRE-BID CONFERENCE" has been modified. The text is as follows:

2. The Section L clause entitled "INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS" has been modified. The text is as follows:

The contractor shall provide the original and 1 copy of the bid. Bids shall include the following: resumes of key personnel and support staff illustrating related project experience. For key personnel not currently employed, letters of intent shall be provided. At least 3 client references (contracts/subcontracts may include those entered into with Federal, State and local governments, an commercial businesses) for which work of a similar nature, magnitude and complexity has been performed within the last 3 years.

Client references shall include: Contract #, title, type, brief description of requirement, total contract value, period of performance, contracting officer (name, phone number and email address), project officer (name, phone number and email address), and a list of subcontractors if applicable.

In addition, the contractor shall provide completed sections B & K of the solicitation and draft plans as follows: draft site/project management plan, including work plan, draft construction quality control plan including quality assurance project plan, and draft site specific health & safety plan.

All bids shall be submitted in "hard copy". No facsimile or electronic bids will be accepted.

Any bid submitted with conditions for acceptance will not be considered.

Any bid that does not include ALL of the above will be rejected as non-responsive.
