

AMENDMENTS TO THE SOLICITATION

1. The attachment entitled "AMENDMENT 1" has been added. The text is as follows:

Regulatory, Analytical and Evaluation Support Services for Radiation Protection Programs

Questions/Answers Regarding PR-NC-09-10242

1. There are 8 Key Positions Listed in the RFP. Can an individual hold more than one Key Position?

Yes, an individual can hold more than one Key Position.

2. Clause L.19 refers to EPA's Mentor-Protege program, but there are no other references to this program in the solicitation. Is participation in the Mentor-Protege program required?

No, participation in the Mentor-Protege program is not required.

3. Is a corporate-level Conflict of Interest (COI) Plan required for larger organizations responding to this request for proposal?

Yes. The COI Plan shall identify all aspects of an organization with relation to the Minimum Standards for Contractor's COI Plans for Clause M.5. Generally this need not exceed three corporate tiers unless a relationship exists beyond the three tiers that would potentially create a conflict.

4. Would EPA accept a Conflict of Interest Plan developed and implemented at the level of the business unit (e.g., division) of the organization that would manage and conduct substantially all work under the contract?

A COI Plan can be at the business unit and/or division level but must still address the Minimum Standards for Contractor's COI Plans with relation to Clause M.5.

5. How much tasking, in terms of staff-hours or full-time equivalents, has the incumbent contractor received during the last 5 years?

6. Should the Conflict of Interest Plan and specific conflict of interest disclosures be provided in the technical proposal or as separate documents?

The Conflict of Interest Plan should be included as part of the Technical Proposal for evaluation purposes.
