



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Office of Acquisition Management in Washington, D.C. intends to award a sole source fixed-price purchase order under authority of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 6.302-1, Other Than Full and Open Competition procedures and FAR Part 13, Simplified Acquisition Procedures, for the acquisition of a Sustainable Products Standards Panel. These services are required to support the Office of Solid Waste and Emergency Response (OSWER) to arrange opportunities for standards developing organizations to meet to discuss the standardization needs within the area of sustainability and products. The Statement of Work (SOW) attached to this notice provides a detailed description of the service required for the acquisition a Sustainable Products Standards Panel.

Based on extensive research effort conducted by the Agency, the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) has continuously proven to be the only vendor capable of satisfactorily meeting the servicing and response requirements of a Standards Panel, in accordance with the SOW. For this reason, it is in the best interest of the Government to award this procurement to the American National Standards Institute (ANSI).

No solicitation or Request for Proposal (RFP) is available for this procurement. Nevertheless, any firm that believes it is capable of meeting the EPA requirements described herein may submit a response; which, if received within seven (7) calendar days of the date of this announcement, will be considered. Responses to this posting must be submitted in writing via e-mail only. A determination not to compete the described purchase order based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Federal Government.
