The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed Nett Technologies' request for an extension on the BlueMAX urea-based selective catalytic reduction system (BlueMAX) to remain on the National Clean Diesel Campaign's Emerging Technologies List. The BlueMAX was initially placed on the list on July 10, 2008.

Based on our evaluation of Nett Technologies' June 29, 2009 progress report and other supporting information, EPA believes Nett Technologies has thus far demonstrated significant progress in the pursuit of full verification for the BlueMAX. Therefore, EPA approves Nett Technologies' request for extension of the BlueMAX to remain on the Emerging Technology List until July 10, 2010.
