The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed Truck Emission Control Technologies Inc's (TECT's) request for an extension of the CAT 3126 PM & NOx Reduction System (PM/NOx 3126) to remain on the National Clean Diesel Campaign's Emerging Technologies List.

Based on our evaluation of TECT's September 18, 2009 progress letter and other supporting information, EPA believes TECT has thus far demonstrated significant progress in the pursuit of full verification for the PM/NOx 3126. Therefore, EPA approves the request for an extension. The PM/NOx 3126 will remain on the Emerging Technology List until October 6, 2010.
