



U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Announces a Five-Year Review is Underway at the Dover Gas Light Company Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 3 is conducting a Five-Year Review at the Dover Gas Light Company Superfund Site (the Site), located in Kent County, Dover, Delaware. EPA conducts reviews at sites every five years to ensure that the remedy continues to meet the cleanup goals, and that the cleanup actions remain protective of human health and the environment.

During the review process, EPA will conduct a Site inspection, review all pertinent documents including those describing recent groundwater and vapor intrusion studies, and discuss the review with community leaders and residents. The expected completion date for this Five-Year Review is Fall 2009.
