



## **CLEANUP WORK STARTED AT THE SPECTRON, INC. SUPERFUND SITE**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will hold an informal Public Information Session to discuss the current cleanup activities being conducted at the Spectron, Inc. Superfund Site (the 'Site'). The Site is located at Providence Road and Little Elk Creek near Elkton, Maryland. Representatives from EPA will be available to discuss any questions or concerns that you may have about the Site.

In January 2007, the EPA entered into an agreement with several companies, referred to as the Potentially Responsible Parties (PRP) Group. Under the terms of the agreement, the PRP Group will perform and fund the remediation of the entire Site.

Cleanup activities started in August 2007 for Operable Unit 1 (OU1). OU1 addresses the soil and shallow groundwater in the 'Plant Area' of the Site. Workers are sampling to determine the presence of Site-related chemicals in the stream and groundwater. Their work also includes cleaning the stream liner system to ensure that it continues to operate efficiently. In addition, data for the Operable Unit 2 Remedial Investigation will be collected from the area of the former facility office, northeast of the creek.
