II. SITUATION

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

The NRC was notified of a tank truck accident and release in Miramar, Broward County, Florida. OSC Stilman was dispatched to the scene. FLDEP BER, Broward County Environmental, and Miramar Fire Rescue were also dispatched to the scene. Upon arrival Miramar Fire Rescue and Broward County placed sorbent berms and ordered the operator, Jacob's Energy to begin recovery operations. Jacob's Energy hired SWS contractor to conduct clean-up operations.

OSC Stilman and FLDEP directed SWS in the recovery of diesel fuel discharged during the accident. Approximately 2,500 gallons of diesel fuel were released. Of that 1,900 gallons were recovered during the evening of the 18th and early morning hours of the 19th. Most of the fuel released from the tank truck flowed to storm drains. The storm drains connect to South Florida Water Management District managed canals. No release beyond the storm drains were found.

At around 0400 on the 19th, the tank truck was removed. Further clean-up will be directed by the Broward County.

IV. FUTURE ACTIONS

No further action by ERRB is anticipated at this time.
