The site is located in Lake County, Florida, 3.8 miles east of the Town of Clermont on County Road 455. The site is located 15 miles west of the City of Orlando.

SETTING:

- The site is zoned for industrial land uses.
- Areas surrounding the site are in residential and commercial use.
- The site is bordered to the east by residences, to the south by an inactive rail line and a residence, and to the west and northwest by a large swamp.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 580 people; 2.5 miles, 5,630 people; 4 miles, 17,751 people.
