DECISION OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)  
TO ADD WATERS TO FLORIDA'S SECTION 303(d) LIST


This notice announces the availability of an EPA decision identifying water quality limited segments and associated pollutants in Florida to be listed pursuant to Clean Water Act Section 303(d)(2), and requests public comment. Section 303(d)(2) requires that states submit, and EPA approve or disapprove, lists of waters for which existing technology-based pollution controls are not stringent enough to attain or maintain state water quality standards and for which total maximum daily loads (TMDLs) must be prepared. On September 2, 2009, EPA partially approved Florida's list submittal for the 2009 listing cycle, approving Florida's listing of an additional 2245 waters, associated pollutants, and associated priority rankings. EPA also independently determined that an additional 34 water quality limited segments (WQLS) should have been included on the list, and has added those waters to Florida's Section 303(d) list.

If you want to comment on EPA's addition of 34 WQLS to Florida's Section 303(d) list, you are invited to submit your comments in writing no later than October 23, 2009.
