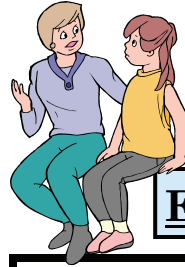
Mercury is a silver liquid at room temperature.

Mercury is toxic.

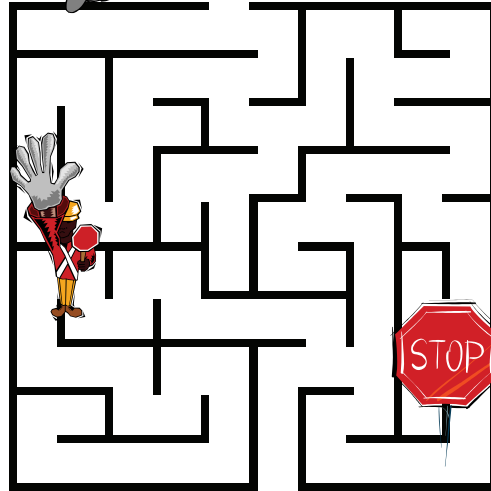
Mercury is also known as quicksilver.
