HFC Allocation Rule Background

- The American Innovation and Manufacturing (AIM) Act of 2020
 - Enacted on December 27, 2020
 - Phases down HFC production and consumption by 85 percent by 2036
- The HFC Allocation Final Rule
 - Published in the Federal Register on October 5, 2021 (86 FR 55116)
 - Establishes an HFC allowance allocation and trading system to phase down HFCs consistent with the AIM Act

Date	Caps: Consumption & Production
2022–2023	90 percent
2024–2028	60 percent
2029–2033	30 percent
2034–2035	20 percent
2036 & after	15 percent

HFC Allocation Rule Background

- Establishes new reporting and recordkeeping requirements for HFC reclaimers and fire suppressant recyclers under 40 CFR part 84
- Reporting requirements are similar to the reporting requirements for HCFCs and other ozone depleting substances (ODS) under 40 CFR Part 82

- ***The HFC Allocation Rule does not replace existing requirements for refrigerant reclaimers under 40 CFR Part 82***

HFC Reporting Requirements

- Reporting for reclaimers and recyclers
 - **Reclaimer One-Time Report:** Submission of a report due February 14, 2022, detailing the quantity of each regulated substance held in inventory as of December 31, 2021 and information on batch testing.
 - **Quarterly Reporting:** Submission of a report within 45 days of the end of each quarter detailing the quantity of HFCs received for reclamation/recycling during the quarter. In the 4th quarter only, include the quantity of each regulated substance held in inventory as of December 31.
- Reports must be submitted to EPA through the HFC Reporting System within the electronic Greenhouse Gas Reporting Tool (e-GGRT)





 - **Company Representative Name** - The designated officer that will serve as the entity's main point of contact for all HFC reporting under the HFC allocation program


