Respondent admits being subject to the Clean Air Act (CAA) and its associated regulations and that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the Respondent's conduct described in Table 2. Respondent does not contest the findings detailed therein, and waives any objections Respondent may have to EPA's jurisdiction.
- 3. Respondent consents to the payment of the penalty in the amount specified in Table 3, attached, incorporated into the Agreement by reference. Respondent agrees to follow the instructions in "CAA Mobile Source Expedited Settlement Agreement Instructions," attached, incorporated into this Agreement by reference. Respondent certifies that the required remediation, detailed in Table 3, has been carried out.
- 4. By its first signature below, EPA ratifies the findings resulting from the inspection and alleged violations set forth in Table 1 and Table 2. Upon signing and returning this Expedited Settlement Agreement to EPA, Respondent consents to EPA's approval of the Expedited Settlement without further notice. Respondent acknowledges that this Expedited Settlement Agreement is binding on the parties signing below, and becomes effective upon the EPA Air Enforcement Division Director's signature.
