Dear Mr. Adamkus:

I certify pursuant to my authority as Attorney General of the State of Wisconsin and in accordance with Title I section 112(1) of the Clean Air Act as amended on November 15, 1990, that in my opinion the laws of Wisconsin: (1) provide adequate authority to implement the Section 112 air toxics standards program described in the application submitted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, 2) adequately enforce compliance with that program, and (3) regulate at a minimum the same sources as the Federal Clean Air Act, and do so with standards that are no less stringent than those specified by the Federal Clean Air Act. I certify, to the best of my knowledge, that the application submitted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is legally accurate. The specific standards provided are contained in statutes or regulations lawfully adopted at the time this Statement is signed and which will be effective by the time this program is approved, or are provided by judicial decisions issued at the time this Statement is signed.
