Dear Mr. Adams:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) issued an Order to Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) on March 14, 2013 which required, pursuant to Paragraph 48, a Work Plan for 2013 oil recovery and assessment activities. Enbridge submitted an inadequate Work Plan on April 4, 2013; U.S. EPA disapproved that Work Plan on April 11, 2013 and gave Enbridge until April 16, 2013 to resubmit an acceptable Work Plan, along with an outline to use in preparing the Work Plan. On April 12, 2013, Enbridge requested an extension for submittal of a revised Work Plan to April 23, 2013.

U.S. EPA approves Enbridge's request for an extension and submittal of a revised Work Plan to the U.S. EPA by 5:00 p.m. Eastern on April 23, 2013. U.S. EPA is prepared and willing to meet with Enbridge immediately, and throughout this week, to answer any questions regarding the detailed content required in the revised Work Plan. The revised Work Plan must be complete and contain all the details required by the Order and U.S. EPA's April 11, 2013 letter.
