Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) is providing this update to the status of the Quantification of Submerged Oil Report (Report) pursuant to the approved Supplement to the Response Plan for Downstream Impacted Areas Commonly Referred to as the Quantification of Submerged Oil Work Plan approved on August 12, 2011. The report was scheduled to be completed within 2 weeks of plan approval which would have been today.

A meeting was held yesterday with representatives of the United State Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) and Enbridge to discuss the Report content. Enbridge was notified in the meeting that additional U.S. EPA and MDEQ data was available and it was requested that this data be utilized in compiling the Report. Due to the timing of the new data exchange, all parties agreed that the submittal of the Quantification of Submerged Oil Report would be extended to September 2, 2011.
