Please find attached a document entitled "Considerations for State I/M Program Optimization." This document was developed by the Office of Transportation and Air Quality (OTAQ) in response to and in collaboration with our regional partners to act as a tool to be used by those states that may be considering optimizing their existing vehicle inspection and maintenance (I/M) programs. This document is purposefully neutral in tone; it does not make recommendations concerning whether or not states should consider optimizing or otherwise revising their I/M programs. This memo also does not address operational and administrative issues affecting the effectiveness of program operation because such issues frequently vary widely from program to program, and often require a site visit to address in any meaningful way. Rather, the considerations are presented in the form of questions that should be addressed by states (using local data, priorities, et cetera) to ensure that the optimization process is as comprehensive and productive as possible. Where OTAQ is aware of information that may play a role in answering these questions above and beyond local considerations, that information has been provided.
