> RE: West Virginia Initial Designations for the 2015 Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards

Dear Administrator Garvin:

On October 1, 2015, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) promulgated revised primary and secondary Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) to provide requisite protection of public health and welfare, respectively. The final rule was published in the Federal Register on October 26, 2015 [80 FR 65292], strengthening both standards to a level of 0.070 parts per million (ppm), while retaining their indicators (O₃), averaging times (eight hours), and forms (fourth-highest daily maximum, averaged across three consecutive years).

In accordance with Section 107(d) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), the State of West Virginia is submitting our initial designations for the revised NAAQS by 1 year after October 1, 2015 [80 FR 65438]. Due to the form of the 2015 Ozone NAAQS relying on a 3-year average, the 3 most recent years of quality assured monitoring data available, 2013 to 2015, were used by the state on which to base our recommendations.

Based upon the latest certified data which has been completely uploaded to EPA's Air Quality System (AQS), for the eight hour, fourth-highest daily maximum for Ozone, averaged across the most recent three consecutive years (2013 to 2015), West Virginia has determined the initial area designations based on the 2015 Ozone NAAQS to be unclassifiable/attainment statewide. Please see the enclosed area list and accompanying air quality design value summary.
