Ohio EPA held a public hearing in Columbus, OH on December 16, 2016, regarding Ohio's draft round 3 recommended nonattainment area designations for the 2010 Sulfur Dioxide standard. This document summarizes the comments and questions received at the public hearing and during the associated comment period, which ended on December 16, 2016.

Ohio EPA reviewed and considered all comments received during the public comment period. By law, Ohio EPA has authority to consider specific issues related to protection of the environment and public health.
