Unofficial Letter of Intention to Convert to Natural Gas

Dear Ms. Van Vlerah:

DTE St. Bernard, LLC (the "Company") currently operates three boilers at the facility. Emission Unit B022 is a 450 MMBtu coal fired and natural gas fired boiler, B043 is a 245 MMBtu natural gas fired boiler with fuel oil backup, and B045 is a 165 MMBtu natural gas fired boiler. To comply with the Industrial Boiler MACT rules, the Company is converting Emission Unit B022 to natural gas only, removing all coal firing capabilities. In addition, fuel oil backup is being added to Emission Unit B045. Both Emission Units B043 and B045 are being permitted to restrict fuel oil firing during natural gas curtailments only. The Company does not have an exact date for conversion; however the estimated date is November 30, 2015. After the conversion, coal will no longer be fired in Emission Unit B022.

Due to the conversion to natural gas, DTE St. Bernard, LLC will emit less than 100 tons per year (TPY) sulfur dioxide (SO2) as described below by the potential to emit (PTE):

 $B022\ PTE\ SO2 = Maximum\ Annual\ Natural\ Gas\ Use\ (3865\ MMscf)\ x\ SO2\ AP-42$ Emission Factor Section 1.4 Table 1.4-2 (0.6 lb/MMscf) / (2000 lb/ton) = 1.2 TPY

Based on the total sulfur dioxide PTE after the conversion is complete, DTE St. Bernard, LLC will emit, facility-wide, less than 100 TPY SO2 and therefore should not be required to perform monitoring or modeling under the US EPA's draft Data Requirements Rule.
