Green Power Partnership Overview

- Summary
 - The U.S. EPA's Green Power Partnership is a voluntary program that encourages organizations to use green power.

- Objectives
 - Reduce U.S. greenhouse gas emissions
 - Expand the voluntary green power market
 - Standardize green power procurement as part of best practice environmental management
- Program Activities
 - Provide technical assistance and tools on procuring green power
 - Provide recognition platform for organizations using green power in the hope that others follow their lead
- 1,400+ Partners procure nearly 37.5 billion kWh annually, equivalent to the annual electric use of more than 3.4 million American homes


Why buy certified?

- EPA recommends, as a consumer best practice, buying green power products that are third-party certified and verified
 - Difficult for buyers of green power to know whether they are buying credible products from credible suppliers
- Certification by an independent third-party offer consumers a higher level of certainty about the integrity of their purchase.
 - Ensures the purchase meets nationally accepted standards for resource and product quality.



Green-e Certified Products in GPP

 Currently, 60% of all green power used by Green Power Partners is certified by Green-e*
