Dear EPA

This is an important and rigorous piece of work – America setting a world standard. I hope this critical work continues to be supported.

I note the potential for improvement in the forest carbon reservoir and stock, which, in the light of current political trends, might be something worth highlighting.

As an addendum, it is interesting that Scotland, a place close to President-elect's heart, recently published its climate action plan (reported by the BBC), and the Scottish parliament's debate of it, and Scotland's new target of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 66% by 2032. They agreed to assign budget to it. It was criticized, however, for not including enough on the need for cuts in emissions from the transport sector, insufficient was made about the potential positive role of the forest sector, and not enough was made of incentives to encourage behavioral change.
