1. That the source and any associated air cleaning devices are to be:
 - a. operated in such a manner as not to cause air pollution;
 - b. in compliance with the specifications and conditions of the Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) plan;
 - c. operated and maintained in a manner consistent with good operating and maintenance practices.

This permit is valid only for the specific equipment, location and owner named above.

5. This operating permit constitutes a RACT determination as per 25 Pa. Code, Sections 129.91 and 129.92 for the above sources.

✓ 6. The number of coaters operated will be limited by the available capacity of the control system.

8. Coaters H, K, L, N, and O are subject to 40 CFR, Part 60, Subpart RR of the Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources and shall comply with all applicable requirements of this Subpart. 40 CFR, §60.4 requires submission of copies of all requests, reports, applications, submittals, and other communications to both EPA and the Department. ✓ 9. The company shall notify the Regional Air Quality Program Manager before the Solvent Recovery System (Croftshaw Engineering) is used in the future.

✓ 10. The company shall maintain monthly records of coating usage and VOC usage for each coater and mix room source group including any cleanup solvents. The report shall include the coating designation, pounds of VOC per gallon of coating minus water, coating density, solvent density, percent solvent by volume, percent solid by volume, and percent water by volume.

✓ 11. The company shall submit an annual report of the data recorded in Condition 13. The report (January 1 through December 31) is due no later than March 1 for the previous calendar year.

12. The company shall maintain the following for the mix room sources:

- a. Closely fitted lids on drum mixing operations.
- b. Nitrogen blankets and conservation vents on stationary mixing tanks.
- c. Vent condensers on the heated mixing vessels.

13. Each surface coating process shall comply with the requirements of 25 Pa. Code, Section 129.52(b).

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Conditions, Continued

14. ✓ The company will only apply (25 Pa. Code, Section 129.52 Table 1) noncompliant coatings when other compliant coatings are being applied and the summation of the allowable emissions from the coatings is greater than the actual emissions from the coaters after control.
15. ✓ The company shall maintain a record of the coatings and application rates of all coatings being applied at times when the noncompliant coatings are being applied. These records shall be maintained for a period of two years.
