- Foundry VOC emissions shall not exceed 5.1 lbs VOC per ton of hot metal (based on a 24 hour average).
- 8. The facility shall show compliance with condition #7 by maintaining monthly records of Foundry VOC containing material purchases, and tons of metal melted.
- Sources identified in this proposal shall be maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations, and in a manner consistent with good air pollution control practices.
