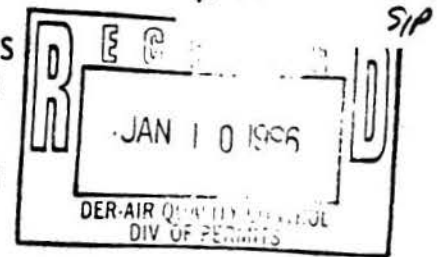


- (a) operated in such a manner as not to cause air pollution;

## Special Conditions

3. This RACT Operating Permit establishes limits to permanently restrict NO<sub>x</sub> emissions to a level below the major source threshold and establishes VOC limits at GenCorp, Inc., Plastic Films Division, located in Jeannette, Westmoreland County.
4. The facility must comply with the conditions placed in O.P. #65-318-052A and the VOC limits required under the Consent Order and Agreement 276MD and 25 Pa. Code §129.
5. Boiler 031 and 032 shall not exceed 24,000 pounds of steam per hour per boiler. Compliance with this limit shall be demonstrated by keeping records of steam usage and making them available to the Department upon request.
6. NO<sub>x</sub> emissions for Boiler 031 or 032 shall not exceed 18.7 tons NO<sub>x</sub> per year for each unit.
5. VOC emissions shall not exceed the following:

Calendering Line 1:	40 tons/year
Calendering Line 2:	40 tons/year
Calendering Line 3:	40 tons/year
Calendering Line 4:	40 tons/year
Embosser Line 1 and Laminator Line 2:	8 tons/year
Cleaning Solvents:	2.70 tons/year
Boiler 031 and Boiler 032:	2 tons/year
Units 1 thru 5:	.5 tons/year

6. The Calendering Lines 1 through 4 combined total emissions shall not exceed 150 tons of VOC per year.
7. Emission reductions of the targeted contaminant(s) below the level specified above which are achieved by optimizing the effectiveness of equipment installed pursuant to this operating permit are not surplus emission reductions, and thus, may not be used to generate Emission Reduction Credits. In order for the emission reductions to be creditable the emission reductions must satisfy the requirements of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 127, Subchapter E.

Special Conditions

- ~~8. This Operating Permit is valid for a limited time only and may be renewed pursuant to 25 PA Code § 127.446 before its expiration. An application for an operating permit renewal shall be submitted at least 6 and not more than 18 months before expiration of the existing permit. The application must be complete and accompanied by the permit fees required by Subchapter I of 25 PA Code Chapter 127. The source may not be operated without a valid operating permit. Operation of the source without an appropriate permit from the Department may subject the company to enforcement action.~~
