WHEREAS, nearly one million septic systems treat wastewater from homes and businesses, serving more than a third of Washington State's population; and

WHEREAS, Washington's on-site wastewater professionals use their expertise in the design, installation, maintenance, and regulation of septic systems in our state; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency's SepticSmart initiative, used by Washington State health agencies, educates homeowners about the need for proper septic system use and encourages routine homeowner maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the people and environment of the state of Washington benefit from properly designed, installed, operated, and maintained septic systems;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Jay Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, do hereby proclaim the week of September 18 through 22, 2017, as

SepticSmart Week

in Washington, and I encourage all people in our state to join me in this special observance.
