- 3. This RACT Operating Permit is for VOC emissions from the GreenSteel Education Products Division of Information Display Technology, Inc. located in Greene Township, Indiana County.
- All spray finish must be applied with air assist airless HVLP spray guns or other devices with equivalent transfer efficiency.
- 5. Emission of total VOCs from the facility shall not exceed 12 tons on an annual basis. Records to establish compliance with this limit shall be maintained on a daily basis and made available to the Department upon request.
- 6. A daily log shall be kept of all VOC-containing spray coatings and solvents purchased and consumed and inventory on hand at the facility. These records shall be maintained in a file for a period of not less than two years and made available to the Department upon request.
- GreenSteel shall make a conscientious effort to replace vinyl sealer and conversion varnish with non-VOC products and progress shall be reported to the Department every six months.
- 8. Emission of toxic air pollutants identified in Title III of the CAAA of 1990 shall not exceed 10 tons per year of any single pollutant and shall not exceed 25 tons per year of the aggregate of all pollutants. GreenSteel shall maintain records on a daily basis and make them available to the Department upon request, which are sufficiently detailed to establish compliance with this condition.
