

- 3. This Operating Permit is for the approval of the RACT Plan as submitted by Ranbar Electrical Materials, Inc. for the continued operation of the Manor Plant and modifications to include the ducting of the resin thinning tank exhausts to an existing fume incinerator at the facility located in Manor Borough, Westmoreland County.
- The facility is to be operated in accordance with the RACT plan submitted as approved herein.
- Facility-wide VOC emissions shall not exceed 112.1 tons/yr combined total, in any 12 month consecutive period. VOC emissions for individual sources shall not exceed the following:

- Ranbar shall keep a daily record of the quantity of all coatings, diluents, and cleaning solvents used and/or manufactured. At a minimum, the record shall contain the gallons of each coating produced, the gallons of solvents used and the weight percent of organic volatiles in the coating and/or solvents.
- Ranbar shall maintain the above records for all coatings and cleaning solvents in stock
 or shipped off-site for disposal for a period of five years and be made available to the
 Department upon request.
- Ranbar shall submit an annual report with the AIMS emissions statement, to include the total amount of each type of coating manufactured for the previous year's operation.
- Ranbar shall install, maintain and operate all combustion sources in accordance within the manufacturers specifications.
- 10. Ranbar shall maintain records in accordance with the recordkeeping requirements of 25 Pa Code Ch. 129.95. The records shall provide sufficient data and calculations to clearly demonstrate that the requirements of 25 Pa Code Ch. 129.91-94 are met and to verify compliance with requirements of this Ract permit. Data and information required to determine compliance shall be recorded and maintained in a time frame consistent with averaging periods to verify compliance. These records shall be retained for at least 2 years and shall be made available to the Department upon request.

- 12. The expiration date shown in the Operating Permit is for state purposes. For federal enforcement purposes, the RACT provisions of this operating permit shall remain in effect as part of the State Implementation Plan (SIP), until replaced pursuant to 40 CFR.

An application for an Operating Permit renewal shall be submitted at least 6 months and not more than 18 months before expiration of the existing permit. The application must be complete and accompanied by the permit fees required by Submapher Lof 25 Pa Code Chapter 127. The source may not be operated without a valid operating permit. Operation of the source without an appropriate permit from the Department may subject the company to enforcement
