- 4. Nitrogen Oxide (NO_X) emissions shall be limited to less than 100 tons per year based on a 12-month running total. Hourly emissions shall not exceed 80 pounds.
- 5. The company shall maintain monthly records of digester and natural gas consumption, hours of operation on each fuel type, and kilowatt output for each co-generator engine.
- 6. The company shall maintain monthly records of total natural gas consumption of the boilers and hours of operation for each boiler. The company shall maintain monthly records of the total digester gas consumption for the waste gas burners.
- 7. The company shall submit an annual report of the data recorded in Condition Nos. 5 and 6 to the Department. The report (January 1 through December 31) is due no later than March 1 for the previous calendar year.
