Background

SmartWay was initiated in 2004 as a voluntary marketbased partnership program with members of the U.S. Freight industry to:

- Improve the efficiency and competitiveness of the freight industry—less fuel consumption = lower fuel costs
- Reduce the release of harmful emissions

Gorton's SmartWay Strategy





- Bidding process improvements; use partnership status as a metric for our bidding process. Carriers with higher scores will conceptually get more business
- 2. Implement a no idle policy; no idling while waiting to get loaded and while being loaded
- 3. Minimize precooling time
- 4. Optimize drop trailer opportunities
- 5. Optimize Intermodal
- 6. Use all electric forklifts
- 7. Leverage SmartWay program participation via web site, packaging, etc.
- 8. Ship product at -1 degrees
- 9. Use SmartWay carriers
- 10. Provide emissions data to customers when requested
