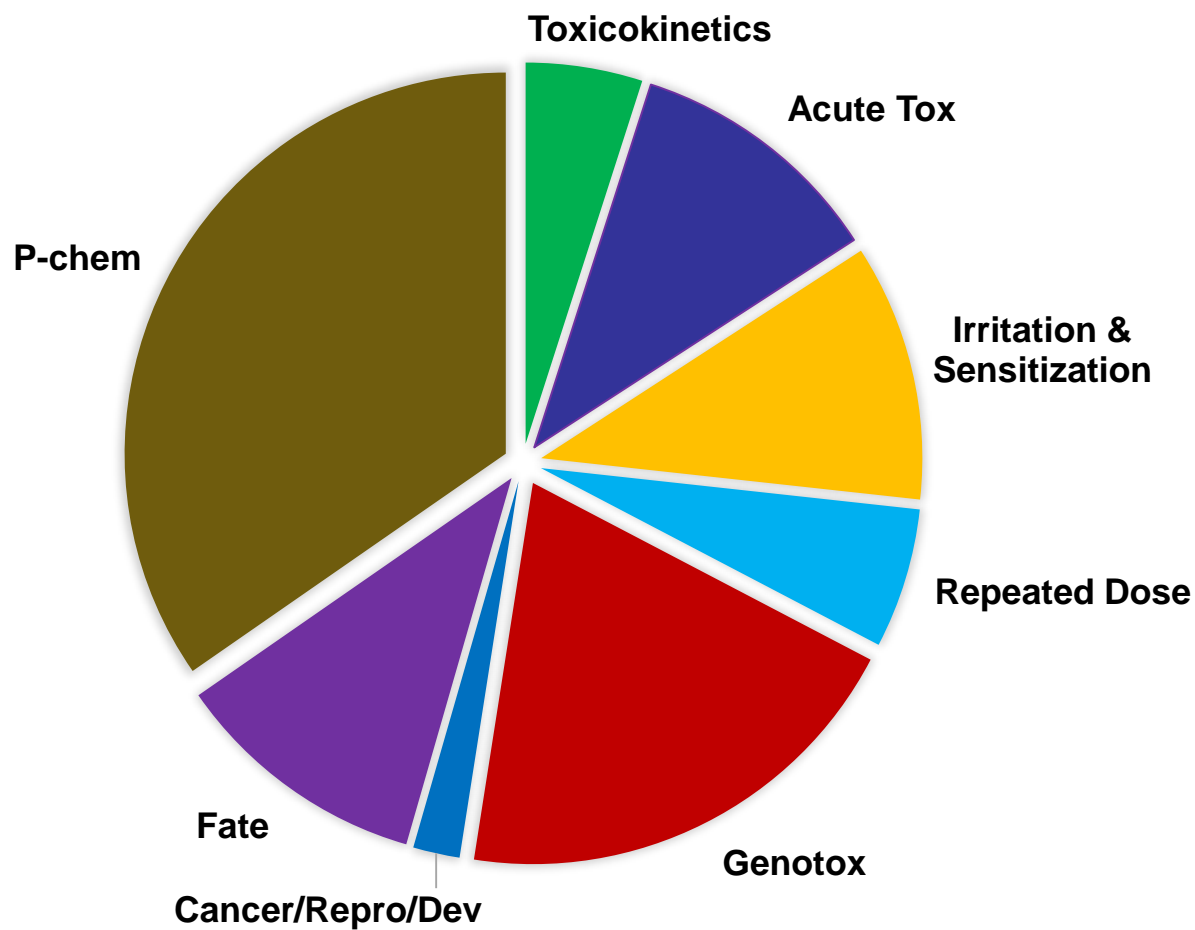


PFAS New Chemicals Activities

Nearly 900 new PFAS chemicals have come through EPA's TSCA program since 2006.

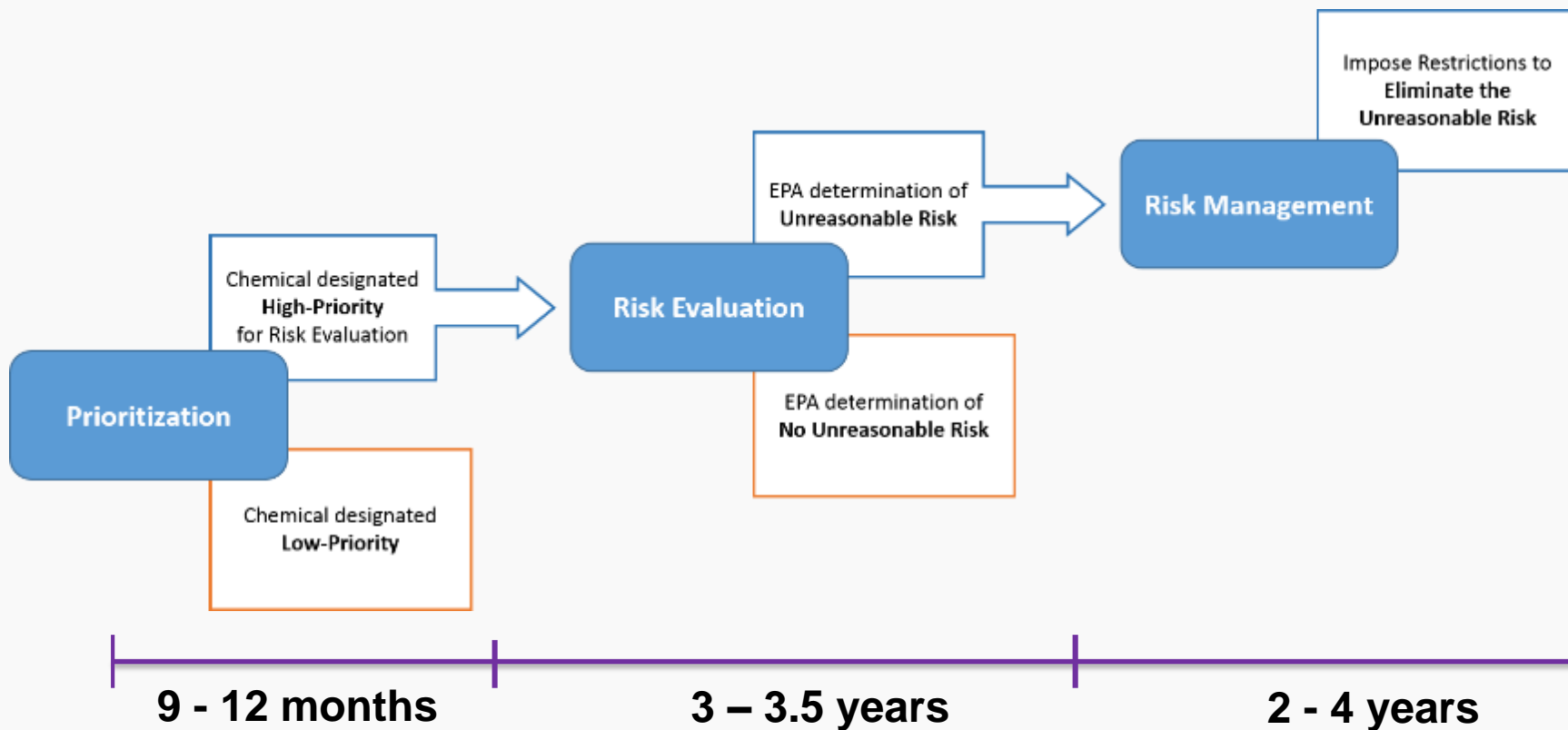
GenX. Currently revising the GenX risk assessment originally done for its pre-market approval, based on data received by the company through TSCA and other means.
