### R5 FY 2018 Clean Diesel Programs

Total: \$7,997,005

- State Program
  - \$2,360,931 (base + incentive bonus)
  - 5 of 6 states provided a match equal to the base allocation,
     receiving match incentive equal to 50% of the base allocation
- National Program (mostly 2-year grants)
  - \$5,636,074 funded 8 competitive proposals
  - Matched by ~\$14.45M





### FY18 Cost Share Breakdown

	Federal	State Matching	Other Matching	Total
State Program	\$2,360,931	\$1,389,101		\$3,750,032
National Competition	\$5,636,074		\$14,457,264	\$20,093,338
Total	\$7,997,005	\$1,389,101	\$14,457,264	\$23,843,370

### How to Fund Projects and Partnerships

- Direct Implementation
  - Target fleet is owned and operated by grant applicant
  - Applicant/recipient's budget reflects only those expenses

incurred by the applicant/recipient

- Subawards
- Participant Support Costs (PSC)
  - Rebates!





### Subawards vs. Participant Support Costs

- Subawards:
  - Applicant is a pass-through entity
  - Subrecipient implements project
  - Administrative costs allowed
  - Special T&Cs
- Participant Support Costs (PSC):
  - Considered "program beneficiary"
  - Program beneficiaries only receive reimbursement for cost-share of eligible projects
  - Exempt from certain reporting requirements

#### **Both: NOT considered contracts**



### Amendments: Modifying an Existing Grant

- Monetary Amendments
  - Incremental
  - Supplemental
  - Decrease
- Non-Monetary Amendments
  - Time Extension
  - Scope of Work Revision
  - Re-budgeting





# Incremental Amendment (Not common with DERA)

- First award may be partial
- Often due to appropriations process
- No action required by grantee
- As Congress provides the EPA funds, the regional offices provide incrementals

First	Second	Third	Total Grant
\$2	\$1	\$1	\$4



### Supplemental Amendment

- Two main instances:
  - Regional offices may "tack on" a new workplan to the previous year's
  - New expenses (not typical with DERA)
- Grantee must provide:
  - SF424, SF424A for new amounts
  - Revised/supplemental workplan and budget narrative

	Grant	Supplement	Final Grant
Time	1 year	1 year	2 year
Funds	\$2	\$3	\$5



### **Decrease Amendment**

- Final congressional appropriation is less than anticipated or grantee returns funds at end of project/budget period
- Submit revised SF424A, workplan, budget narrative
  - Decreases in parenthesis in SF424A
  - Adjust match
  - Need for signed SF424 depends (PO will inform)

Original Grant	Decrease	Final Grant
\$5	\$1	\$4



### **Time Extension Amendment**

- Additional time needed to complete the workplan objectives.
- PO should be notified well in advance of end date
- Request
  - Reason
  - New timeline
- May not be used to expend remaining balance!



### Re-budgeting Amendment

- Amount to re-budget exceeds 10%
- Revised SF424A
- NOTE:
  - Even re-budgets less than 10% must be documented
  - PO should be informed via email
  - Costs must always be allowable, allocable, reasonable, and necessary



### Scope of Work Revision Amendment

Grantee submits a revised workplan.

- Often occurs together with:
  - Supplemental
  - Re-budgeting
  - Decrease





### **Advanced Monitoring**

- Required to perform advanced monitoring on 10% of grants/CY
  - Not an audit
- Included in CY19 plan:
  - Three National Clean Diesel Grants
  - Grantees with multiple grants open
- Scope: Activities are eligible under existing federal statutes
- Time: Completion of grant deliverables within the project/budget period
- Cost: Drawdowns of funds are timely



### Will my project be audited?

Work with the Regional Office & EPA Office of the Inspector General (OIG)

#### **Documentation:**

- Application, agreements, amendments, contracts and subcontracts
- Accounting records, including disbursement of funds, travel, records of in-kind contributions, etc.
- Copies of performance reports and any other reports or products developed under the agreement
- Copies of Financial Status Reports
- Copies of any requests for reimbursements



### R5 FY19 Clean Diesel Programs

- State Program
  - FY17-18 grants project period ends September 30, 2019
- National Program
  - 12 eligible applications in R5
  - New awards expected start date: August 1, 2019
- DERA Reauthorization
  - Congress considering DERA through 2024 at \$100M/year



### FY19 State Updates

- Dates:
  - April 29 Notice of Intent to Participate (NOIP) due to HQ
  - May 28 Submit draft workplan
  - June 18 Final workplan in grants.gov
- Funding:
  - ~ \$25M total pot
  - $\sim $314,000 \text{ (base)} + $157,000 \text{ (bonus)} = $471,000$
- New grant for FY19
  - Not supplementals to FY17-18 grants
  - Two-year project periods
  - FY20 funding will add as a supplemental to the FY19
