

Camping and RV

Camping and RV (no hookups) is available at Noyo-Bida Ranch at no cost. If you will be bringing an RV please contact Jade Swor (pvtepatech@pottervalleytribe.com) to reserve a spot so that the Potter Valley Tribe can plan the area appropriately.

Hotels

Directions to Potter Valley Tribe, Noyo-bida Ranch – 21801 N Highway 1, Ft Bragg:

From the south – Go through Ft Bragg on Hwy 1. Just past the wooden trestle bridge on the left are motels. Turn in opposite the Breakers Motel and drive up to the ranch house. To get to the clubhouse, go further to Airport Rd, then turn right. Go about 0.4 miles to first gate on the right.

From the north – Pass MacKerricher State Park to Airport Rd, just before the city of Ft Bragg. To get to the clubhouse, go left on Airport Rd. Go about 0.4 miles to first gate on the right. To get to the ranch house, turn in the driveway on the left, opposite the Breakers Motel.
