

EPA Responsibilities:

- Reviewing all components of delegation request package submitted by VI government agencies.
- Providing public notice of VI delegation request.
- Preparing responsiveness summary and all other public comment documentation.
- Publication of delegation decision in Federal Register.
- Approval of V.I. delegation request.

NOTE: EPA retains all of its enforcement authority.



Governor's Responsibilities:

- Approval of all documentation comprising the delegation request.
- Conferring with EPA to ensure that all delegation components are acceptable.
- Facilitating all inter-agency communication and contacts with **EPA**

DPNR's Commissioner Responsibilities:

- Review and approval of all enforcementrelated actions with respect to landfill violations.
- Coordinate inter-agency discussions.
- Develop inter-agency agreements regarding implementation of RCRA Subtitle D provisions.

DEP Director Responsibilities:

- Facilitating Inter-agency meetings.;
- Development of inter-agency agreements w/ key program staff participation.
- Review and approval of all compliancerelated correspondence and enforcement actions prepared by staff.

DPW Responsibilities:

Construction and maintenance of all roads at landfills and transfer stations.

DEH Responsibilities:

Conducting routine inspections to ensure that garbage is managed in a manner that will minimize the breeding of flies, mosquitoes and other disease vectors.

SW Program Responsibilities:

- Conducting routine inspections of landfills and transfer station.
- Implementation and enforcement of all requirements under Title 19, Chapter 56.
- Implementation of 40 CFR Part 279 provisions regarding used oil.

WPC Program Responsibilities:

- Regulatory oversight of runoff control measures that are implemented by WMA. Compliance monitoring inspections regarding Clean Water Act provisions.
 - Ambient monitoring of environmental impacts to lagoon and water bodies thru guarterly sampling (nutrients, pH, dissolved oxygen, fecal, turbidity and temperature.)

HW Program Responsibilities:

Monitoring/tracking e-waste and lead acid batteries and other hazardous wastes collected and stored at landfills. Oversight of waste tire (managed as a special waste) collection and disposal activities.

APC Responsibilities:

- Regulatory oversight of gas collection and control system for non methane organic compound emissions.
- Responding to complaints regarding dust and fugitive emissions.
- Enforcement of the CAA Title V provisions
- Inspections for Title V compliance monitoring.
- Title V permitting process activities.

DEP Legal Responsibilities:

- Review of all enforcement actions prepared by staff. Conducting informal
- settlement conferences. Assisting with rule development process.

Groundwater Program Responsibilities:

- Monitoring Impacts to Perched Aquifer and Groundwater.
 - Issuing permits for soil/well borings.
