Dear Mr. Baris and Mr. Kenny,

Bayer CropScience LP respectfully petitions EPA to extend the period of exclusive data use for Indaziflam by 3 years, by applying the provision listed under FIFRA Section 3(c)(1)(F)(ii).

Bayer CropScience believes that Indaziflam meets the criteria required for this provision based on currently registered uses on minor crops including: sweet cherry, pistachio, lemon, pear, olive, blueberry (highbush), raspberry, hops, coffee (arabic), lime, tart cherry and apricots, thus qualifying for the maximum of three additional years of data exclusivity. Justification for how Indaziflam meets the criteria requirements are detailed in the enclosed data exclusivity extension petition (MRID #50904801).

We have determined that the proper PRIA code for this submission is M007, with an corresponding fee of \$5,513. Please use \$5,513 from payment A264954315 which currently has \$50,445 available, as a PRIA credit (payment date of 3/20/2018).
