

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0029149

The facility is located at 316 Maxwell Ave, Maxwell, Colfax County, New Mexico. The Maxwell WWTP has a design flow capacity of 0.02 MGD serving a residential population of 340 and is classified as a minor municipal discharger under the Federal Clean Water Act, Section 402, of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit program. The facility discharge is to unnamed dry arroyo, thence to Canadian River in Segment No. 20.6.4.305 of the Canadian River Basin.

This is a renewal of a permit previously issued May 30, 2014, with an effective date of July 1, 2014, and an expiration date of June 30, 2019 are:

Changes from the previous permit are:

- Sufficiently Sensitive Methods requirements have been added; and,
- DMR electronic reporting requirements have been added.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the anti-degradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
