

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0031038

The permittee is authorized to discharge from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 36° 30' 27" North, Longitude 104° 53' 45" West. Under the SIC 4952, the discharger is a POTW with a design flow of 0.0083 serving a population of approximately 1,200. The facility discharges to the French Lake, a tributary of the Cimarron River, designated as segment number 20.6.4.306. The designated uses of the receiving waters are irrigation, warmwater aquatic life, livestock watering, wildlife habitat and primary contact.

This is a renewal of a permit issued September 30, 2015, with an effective date of November 1, 2015, and an expiration date of October 31, 2020.

Changes to the draft permit from the previous permit are:

- Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) results shall be electronically reported to EPA per 40 CFR 127.16.
- DO has been added as a monitoring requirement only in this draft permit.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
