If you would like to provide Public Testimony, please CALL - 844 277-1775 and use conference ID 9473297 to join the call. After you have joined the call please PRESS *1 (Star 1) on your telephone keypad to join the Public Testimony Queue.

Speakers will be heard in the order they signed up. Before it is your turn to speak, the operator will announce your name and ask you to begin.

Each speaker will be given THREE MINUTES to provide testimony. When three minutes have passed, the Hearing Officer will say the words “THREE MINUTES.” At this time, please conclude your remarks as quickly as possible. If you do not very quickly conclude your remarks, the operator will mute your line and announce the next speaker.

If there is time remaining after the hearing officer has taken all testimony, speakers who were not able to finish in the allotted three minutes will have an opportunity to conclude their remarks. Oral testimony will be given the same weight as written comments, so if your remarks are lengthy, please consider submitting them as provided in the public notice. EPA will continue to accept written comments through January 11, 2021.
