Adding the ATTAINS Geospatial Service to ArcGIS Pro

1. In ArcGIS Pro right-click the Catalog pane on the right side of the window and select **New ArcGIS Server Connection**



2. In the dialog box that shows up, enter <u>https://gispub.epa.gov/arcgis/rest/services/</u> <u>OW/ATTAINS Assessment/MapServer</u> under **Server URL** and click **OK**
