SUBJECT: Clarification of the listing policy
for Federal facilities

TO: Superfund Site Assessment/Evaluation Branch
Chiefs, Regions I-10

The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify the position of the Superfund Site Assessment program with regards to listing Federal Facilities "fenceline to fenceline," as discussed during the Site Assessment Section Chiefs conference call on August 17, 1994. The Agency policy is not to automatically list sites on a "fenceline to fenceline" basis.

Options available are included in the attached memorandum written by George Wyeth and dated, August 13, 1991 (attached). Where adequate data is available (a completed RI or ESI which adequately characterizes the entire facility), it is possible to include only those portions of a facility which are contaminated on the NPL (see page 5 of the Wyeth memo). Where adequate data is not available a different approach must be taken.
