

**Non-Material Modification of Consent Agreement
Between the United States Environmental Protection Agency
and the Department of the Interior**

The Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of the Interior have agreed to modify the Consent Agreement ratified by the Environmental Appeals Board on August 18, 2011. The agreed upon modification extends the deadline for DOI to submit the schedule for audits to be conducted during the first quarter of FY 2012. The Consent Agreement requires that schedule to be submitted at least 30 days prior to the start of the fiscal quarter, which in this case is September 1, 2011. The parties hereby agree that DOI may submit this schedule no later than 30 days prior to the first audit to be conducted during the first quarter of FY 2012.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency consents to the above modification of the Consent Agreement, by its duly authorized representative on this 2 day of September 2011.
