ACTIVITY: EPA proposes to re-issue an NPDES permit for discharge from a ground water cleanup activity at Building 52A, Denver Federal Center, Denver, CO. The groundwater contains contaminants released by a former leaking underground storage tank and is treated prior to discharge.
