I. JURISDICTION

1. This Administrative Order on Consent ("Consent Order" or "Order") is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the President of the United States by Section 122(g)(4) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(4), to reach settlements in actions under Section 106 or 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 or 9607. The authority vested in the President has been delegated to the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") by Executive Order 12580, 52 Fed. Reg. 2923 (Jan. 29, 1987), further delegated to the Regional Administrators of the EPA by EPA Delegation No. 14-14-E, and further delegated to the Chief of the Waste Programs Branch, EPA Region 4, by Regional Delegation No. 14-14-E.

2. This Administrative Order on Consent is issued to the persons, corporations, or other entities identified in Appendix C ("Respondents"). Each Respondent agrees to undertake all actions required by this Consent Order. Each Respondent further consents to and will not contest EPA's jurisdiction to issue this Consent Order or to implement or enforce its terms.

3. EPA and Respondents agree that the actions undertaken by Respondents in accordance with this Consent Order do not constitute an admission of any liability by any Respondent. Respondents do not admit, and retain the right to controvert in any subsequent proceedings other than proceedings to implement or enforce this Consent Order, the validity of the Statement of Facts or Determinations contained in Sections IV and V, respectively, of this Consent Order.

II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

4. By entering into this Consent Order, the mutual objectives of the Parties are:

a. to reach a final settlement among the Parties pursuant to Section 122(g) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g), which requires Respondents to make a cash payment to resolve their alleged civil liability under Sections 106 and 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 and 9607 for injunctive relief and for Past and Future Response Costs (as hereinafter defined) incurred or to be incurred at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites (as hereinafter defined), thereby reducing litigation related to the Cherokee Sites;

b. to reduce subsequent administrative and judicial enforcement activities concerning the Cherokee Sites by settling the liability of a substantial number of potentially responsible parties concerning Past and Future Response Costs related to the Cherokee Sites; and

c. to obtain settlement with Respondents for their fair share of Past and Future Response Costs incurred at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites from the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund, and to provide for contribution protection for Past and Future Response Costs for Respondents with regard to the Cherokee Sites pursuant to Sections 113(f)(2) and 122(g)(5) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613(f)(2) and 9622(g)(5).

III. DEFINITIONS

5. Unless otherwise expressly provided herein, terms used in this Consent Order that are defined in CERCLA or in regulations promulgated under CERCLA shall have the meaning assigned to them in the statute or regulations. Whenever the terms listed below are used in this Consent Order, the following definitions shall apply:

a. "CERCLA" shall mean the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 9601, et seq.

b. "Cherokee Sites" or "Sites" shall mean collectively: (1) the Cherokee Oil Summit Avenue Removal Site, located at 925 South Summit Avenue, Charlotte, North Carolina, and comprised of approximately 2 acres (the "Summit Avenue Site") and; (2) the Cherokee Oil Berryhill Road Removal Site, located at 1201 Berryhill Road, Charlotte, North Carolina, and comprised of approximately 1.5 acres (the "Berryhill Road Site"). The Cherokee Sites are more fully depicted on the maps attached hereto as Appendix B.

c. "Consent Order" or "Order" shall mean this Administrative Order on Consent and all appendices attached hereto. In the event of conflict between this Order and any appendix, the Order shall control.

d. "de micromis parties" shall mean that group of parties listed in Appendix D whom, according to documentation obtained by EPA, have sent less than 1360 gallons to the Cherokee Sites.

e. "de minimis parties" shall mean that group of parties listed in Appendix C whom, according to documentation obtained by EPA, have sent less than 20,000 gallons but at least 1360 gallons to the Cherokee Sites.

f. "Day" shall mean a calendar day. In computing any period of time under this Consent Order, where the last day would fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or federal holiday, the period shall run until the close of business of the next working day.

g. "EPA" shall mean the United States Environmental Protection Agency and any successor departments, agencies or instrumentalities.

h. "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund" shall mean the Hazardous Substance Superfund established by the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 9507.

i. "Future Response Costs" shall mean all costs of "response" as that term is defined by Section 101(25) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(25), incurred by EPA, on and after the effective date of this Agreement, in relation to either or both of the Cherokee Sites.

j. "Interest" shall mean interest at the current rate specified for interest on investments of the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund established by 26 U.S.C. § 9507, compounded annually on October 1 of each year, in accordance with 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a).

k. "Paragraph" shall mean a portion of this Consent Order identified by an arabic numeral.

l. "Parties" shall mean EPA and the Respondents.

m. "Past Response Costs" shall mean all costs of "response" as that term is defined by Section 101(25) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(25), incurred by EPA, prior to the effective date of this Agreement, in relation to either or both of the Cherokee Sites.

n. "Respondents" shall mean those persons, corporations, or other entities listed in Appendix C.

o. "Section" shall mean a portion of this Consent Order identified by a roman numeral.

p. "United States" shall mean the United States of America, including its departments, agencies and instrumentalities.

IV. STATEMENT OF FACTS

6. Cherokee Resources, Inc. (d/b/a Cherokee Oil or Southtec Corporation) operated an oil recycling facility at the Berryhill Road Site. This unpermitted facility also accepted hazardous wastes. In 1990, a corporate affiliate of Cherokee Resources leased the Summit Avenue Site for the purpose of storing waste materials which, due to space constrictions, could not be stored at the Berryhill Road Site. During the period of operation of the Summit Avenue Site, Cherokee Resources freely transported waste materials back and forth between the two Sites.

7. In July 1991, EPA investigated the Summit Avenue Site and concluded that the Site posed an imminent fire and explosion hazard to neighboring businesses and residents and a threat of release of hazardous substances to the environment. After EPA secured control of the Summit Avenue Site, EPA discovered approximately 6066 drums of various liquids and solids, thirteen roll-offs of contaminated soil, two tankers trucks containing liquid waste, four underground storage tanks and other trailers containing drums. The wastes stored at the Summit Avenue Site included polychlorinated biphenyls, highly flammable solvents, cyanides, strong acids and bases, hazardous organic compounds and hazardous inorganic substances. The wastes were stabilized and analyzed by EPA, and EPA ultimately shipped the wastes to appropriate disposal facilities. After the completion of the removal action, a Site Inspection was conducted at the Summit Avenue Site. On April 20, 1994, EPA determined that no further remedial action was necessary for the Summit Avenue Site.

8. In August 1994, EPA conducted a site inspection of the Berryhill Road Site, and verified the presence of large quantities of hazardous substances that posed an immediate threat to nearby residents and/or the environment. Investigators discovered four tanks inside a warehouse, approximately 2,856 drums of randomly stored waste materials, two vats, twelve above-ground storage tanks, three underground storage tanks, and two tanker trucks. The conditions at the Berryhill Road Site prompted EPA to initiate an emergency removal action. During the course of the removal action, EPA consolidated compatible tank and drum wastes. The final waste groups were sent off-site for

disposal. Wastes found on the Site included: organic sludges, oxidizers, peroxides and sulfides, and acidic, flammable and caustic liquids. After the completion of the removal action, a Site Inspection was conducted at the Berryhill Road Site. On October 15, 1996, EPA determined that no further remedial action was necessary for the Berryhill Road Site.

9. The majority of the waste materials accepted by Cherokee Oil representatives were co-mingled during operation and randomly moved between the two facilities. Consequently, the generators, transporters and arrangers for disposal of the waste materials found at the Cherokee Sites have potential liability for the costs incurred by EPA at both the Berryhill Road Site and the Summit Avenue Site. Therefore, for purposes of reimbursing EPA, the Parties have agreed to jointly address all applicable costs in one administrative action.

10. Hazardous substances were threatened to be released at or from the Cherokee Sites prior to and during the removal actions.

11. As a result of the release or threatened release of hazardous substances, EPA has undertaken response actions at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites under Section 104 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604, and may undertake response actions in the future.

12. In performing these response actions at the Cherokee Sites, EPA has incurred and may continue to incur response costs at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites. As of September 23, 1996, EPA has incurred \$3,134,562.07 in connection with the Summit Avenue Site and \$2,995,251.47 in connection with the Berryhill Road Site.

13. Each Respondent listed on Appendix C arranged for disposal or treatment, or arranged with a transporter for transport for disposal or treatment of a hazardous substance owned, possessed or generated by such Respondent, at the Cherokee Sites, or accepted a hazardous substance for transport to the Cherokee Sites which was selected by Respondent.

14. The amount of hazardous substances contributed, transported or arranged to be transported to the Site by each Respondent does not exceed 0.1475% or 20,000 gallons of the known hazardous substances sent to the Site, and the hazardous substances contributed by each Respondent to the Site are not significantly more toxic or of significantly greater hazardous effect than other hazardous substances at the Site. Attached hereto as Appendix C is a listing of the volume of the hazardous substances contributed to the Cherokee Sites by each Respondent and an allocation of the amounts owed to EPA by each Respondent.

15. EPA anticipates that approximately \$6,500,000 will be expended by the United States for these Sites. The payment required to be made by each Respondent pursuant to this Consent Order is a minor portion of the total Response Costs incurred or to be incurred in connection with the Cherokee Sites.

V. DETERMINATIONS

16. Based upon the Statement of Facts set forth above and on the administrative record for this Site, EPA has determined that:

a. The Berryhill Road Site and the Summit Avenue Site are each a "facility" as that term is defined in Section 101(9) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(9).

b. Each Respondent is a "person" as that term is defined in Section 101(21) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(21).

c. Each Respondent is a "potentially responsible party" within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1).

d. There has been an actual or threatened "release" of a "hazardous substance" from the Cherokee Sites as those terms are defined in Section 101(22) and (14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(22) and (14).

e. The actual or threatened "release" caused the incurrence of response costs.

f. Prompt settlement with each Respondent is practicable and in the public interest within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1).

g. As to each Respondent, this Consent Order involves only a minor portion of the response costs at the Cherokee Sites within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1).

h. The amount of hazardous substances attributed to each Respondent and the toxic or other hazardous effects of the hazardous substances attributed to each Respondent are minimal in comparison to other hazardous substances at the Site within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1)(A) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1)(A).

VI. ORDER

17. Based upon the administrative records for the Sites and the Statement of Facts and Determinations set forth above, and in

consideration of the promises and covenants set forth herein, the following is hereby AGREED TO AND ORDERED:

18. a. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Consent Order, each Respondent shall pay to the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund the amount set forth in Appendix A to this Consent Order.

b. Each Respondent's payment includes an amount for: a) past response costs incurred at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites; b) a premium to address projected future response costs to be incurred at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites; and, c) a portion of the past costs attributable to defunct, insolvent, unlocatable and de micromis parties.

19. Each payment shall be made by certified or cashier's check made payable to "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund." Each check shall reference the name and address of the party making payment, the Site name, the EPA Region and Site Spill ID Number, 04WD/04SL, and the EPA docket number for this action, and shall be sent to:

VII. FAILURE TO MAKE PAYMENT

21. If any Respondent fails to make full payment within the time required by Paragraph 18, that Respondent shall pay Interest on the unpaid balance. In addition, if any Respondent fails to make full payment as required by Paragraph 18, the United States may, in addition to any other available remedies or sanctions, bring an action against that Respondent seeking injunctive relief to compel payment and/or seeking civil penalties under Section 122(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(1), for failure to make timely payment.

VIII. CERTIFICATION OF RESPONDENT

22. By signing this Consent Order, each Respondent certifies, individually, that, to the best of its knowledge and belief:

a. if an Information Request was sent to Respondent from EPA, the Respondent has conducted a thorough, comprehensive, good faith search for documents, and has fully and accurately disclosed to EPA, all information currently in its possession, or in the possession of its officers, directors, employees, contractors or agents, which relates in any way to the ownership, operation, or control of the Cherokee Sites, or to the ownership, possession, generation, treatment, transportation, storage or disposal of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant at or in connection with the Sites;

b. the Respondent has not altered, mutilated, discarded, destroyed or otherwise disposed of any records, documents, or other information relating to its potential liability regarding the Cherokee Sites after notification of potential liability or the filing of a suit against it regarding the Cherokee Sites;

c. the Respondent has fully complied with any and all EPA requests for information regarding the Sites pursuant to Sections 104(e) and 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9604(e) and 9622(e); and,

d. the Respondent has reviewed the volume of material attributed to it stated on Appendices A and C and has no belief or knowledge that this volume does not accurately reflect the volume of material sent or transported by it to the Cherokee Resources facilities.

IX. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY UNITED STATES

23. In consideration of the payments that will be made by Respondents under the terms of this Consent Order, and except as specifically provided in Section X (Reservations of Rights by United States), the United States covenants not to sue or take administrative action against any of the Respondents pursuant to Sections 106 or 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 or 9607, for matters relating to the Cherokee Sites. These covenants not to sue shall take effect for each Respondent upon receipt of that Respondent's payment as required by Section VI. With respect to each Respondent, individually, this covenant not to sue is conditioned upon:

a) the satisfactory performance by Respondent of all obligations under this Consent Order; and

b) if requested by EPA, the veracity of the information provided to EPA by Respondent relating to Respondent's involvement with the Cherokee Sites. This covenant not to sue extends only to named Respondents and does not extend to any other person.

X. RESERVATIONS OF RIGHTS BY UNITED STATES

24. The covenant not to sue by the United States set forth in Paragraph 23 does not pertain to any matters other than those expressly specified in Paragraph 23. The United States reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, all rights against Respondents with respect to all other matters including, but not limited to:

a. liability for failure to meet a requirement of this Consent Order;

b. criminal liability;

c. liability for damages for injury, to, destruction of, or loss of natural resources, and for the costs of any natural resource damage assessments; or

d. liability arising from any future arrangement for disposal or treatment of a hazardous substance, pollutant or contaminant at the Cherokee Sites after the effective date of this Consent Order.

25. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Consent Order, including the provisions of Section IX (Covenant Not to Sue), the United States reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, the right to institute judicial or administrative proceedings against any individual Respondent seeking to compel that Respondent to perform response actions relating to the Cherokee Sites, and/or to reimburse the United States for additional costs of response, if:

a. information is discovered which indicates that such Respondent contributed hazardous substances to the Cherokee Sites in such greater amount or of such greater toxic or other hazardous effects that such Respondent no longer qualifies as a de minimis party at the Site because such Respondent contributed greater than 0.1475% of the hazardous substances at the Cherokee Sites, or greater than 20,000 gallons of hazardous substances at the Cherokee Sites, or contributed hazardous substances which are significantly more toxic or are of significantly greater hazardous effect than the other hazardous substances at the Cherokee Sites.

XI. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY RESPONDENTS

26. Respondents covenant not to sue and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against the United States or its contractors or employees with respect to the Cherokee Sites or this Consent Order including, but not limited to:

a. any direct or indirect claim for reimbursement from the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund based on Sections 106(b)(2), 107, 111, 112, or 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(b)(2), 9607, 9611, 9612, or 9613, or any other provision of law;

b. any claims arising out of Past and Future Response Costs at the Cherokee Sites; and

c. any claim against the United States pursuant to Sections 107 and 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613, relating to the Site.

27. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be deemed to constitute preauthorization or approval of a claim within the meaning of Section 111 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9611, or 40 C.F.R. 300.700(d).

28. Respondents covenant not to sue and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against each other or against the de micromis parties listed on Appendix D with regard to Past and Future Response Costs for the Cherokee Sites, pursuant to Sections 107 and 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613.

XII. EFFECT OF SETTLEMENT/CONTRIBUTION PROTECTION

29. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to create any rights in, or grant any cause of action to, any person not a Party to this Consent Order. Except for the provisions of paragraph 28, the United States and Respondents each reserve any and all rights (including, but not limited to, any right to contribution), defenses, claims, demands, and causes of action which each Party may have with respect to any matter, transaction, or occurrence relating in any way to the Cherokee Sites against any person not a Party hereto.

30. In any subsequent administrative or judicial proceeding initiated by the United States for injunctive relief, recovery of response costs, or other relief relating to the Cherokee Sites, Respondents shall not assert, and may not maintain, any defense or claim based upon the principles of waiver, res judicata, collateral estoppel, issue preclusion, claim-splitting, or other defenses based upon any contention that the claims raised in the subsequent proceeding were or should have been brought in the instant action; provided, however, that nothing in this Paragraph

affects the enforceability of the covenant not to sue included in Paragraph 23.

31. The Parties agree that each Respondent is entitled, as of the effective date of this Consent Order, to such protection from contribution actions or claims as is provided by Sections 113(f)(2) and 122(g)(5) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613(f)(2) and 9622(g)(5), for "matters addressed" in this Consent Order. The "matters addressed" in this Consent Order are all response actions that have been taken by the United States and by private parties, and all response costs incurred and to be incurred by the United States and by private parties, at or in connection with the Cherokee Sites.

XIII. PARTIES BOUND

32. This Consent Order shall apply to and be binding upon EPA and upon Respondents and their heirs, successors and assigns. Any change in ownership or corporate or other legal status of a Respondent, including but not limited to, any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall in no way alter such Respondent's responsibilities under this Consent Order. Each signatory to this Consent Order certifies that he or she is authorized to enter into the terms and conditions of this Consent Order and to execute and bind legally the party represented by him or her.

XIV. INTEGRATION/APPENDICES

33. This Consent Order and its appendices constitute the final, complete and exclusive agreement and understanding among the Parties with respect to the settlement embodied in this Consent Order. The Parties acknowledge that there are no representations, agreements or understandings relating to the settlement other than those expressly contained in this Consent Order. The following appendices are attached to and incorporated into this Consent Order:

"Appendix A" is information relating directly to the recipient Respondent.

"Appendix B" are maps of the Cherokee Sites.

"Appendix C" is the volumetric allocation of all eligible de minimis parties and the amount to be paid for each of them.

"Appendix D" is a list of de micromis parties.

XV. PUBLIC COMMENT

34. This Consent Order shall be subject to a public comment period of not less than 30 days pursuant to Section 122(i) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i). In accordance with Section 122(i)(3) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i)(3), EPA may withdraw or withhold its consent to this Consent Order if comments received disclose facts or considerations which indicate that this Consent Order is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate.


XVI. ATTORNEY GENERAL APPROVAL
