Re: Final Comments on Outstanding Issues from the OU3 (Uplands) Baseline Human Health Risk Assessment: LCP Chemical National Priorities List Site, Brunswick, Glynn County, GA

Dear Mr. Gupta:

Below are the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's and the Georgia Environmental Protection Division's (GaEPD's) comments on Honeywell, Inc's (Honeywell's) April 25, 2011 OU3 Baseline Human Health Risk Assessment (HHRA) submittal. As we agreed in our June 8, 2011 meeting, the discussion of contaminant leaching to groundwater considerations should be moved from the OU3 HHRA to the Technical Memorandum of the Feasibility Study.

Exhibit 1 A – Revised Contaminants of Potential Concern (COPC) Screening Off-Site Tank Farm:

- a. 4-Chloro-3-methylphenol: The adjusted residential value should be 610 mg/kg.
- b. Chloromethane: The adjusted residential value should be 12 mg/kg.
- c. Trans-1,2-Dichloroethene: The adjusted residential value should be 15 mg/kg.
- d. Thallium: There is no current residential screening level (RSL) value.

Exhibit 2 A – Revised COPC Screening Quad 1:

- a. 1,3-Dichloropropane: The adjusted residential value should be 160 mg/kg.
- b. Chloromethane: The adjusted residential value should be 12 mg/kg.
- c. Trichloroethene: The adjusted residential value should be 2.8 mg/kg.
- d. Thallium: There is no current RSL value.

Exhibit 3 A – Revised COPC Screening Quad 2:

- a. 1,3-Dichloropropane: The adjusted residential value should be 160 mg/kg.
- b. Chloromethane: The adjusted residential value should be 12 mg/kg.
- c. Trans-1,2-Dichloroethene: The adjusted residential value should be 15 mg/kg.
- d. Thallium: There is no current RSL value.

Exhibit 5 A – Revised COPC Screening Quad 4:


- a. Chloromethane: The adjusted residential value should be 12 mg/kg.

- d. Thallium: There is no current RSL value.

Note that the preceding comment on thallium also applies to Exhibits 1B, 2B, 3B, 4B and 5B.

Please submit, to my attention, within 21 business days of receipt of this letter, the revised OU3 HHRA. Upon receipt of this revision, the EPA will consult with the GaEPD and then proceed to approve, disapprove, or modify the resubmitted HHRA, pursuant to Section VIII, Paragraph D of the Administrative Order by Consent for Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study, EPA Docket Number 95-17-C.
