

Pesticide Registration Service Fees

Partnership Grants

Under PRIA 2, the amounts set aside for partnership grants in Section 33(c)(3)(B)(ii) were \$750,000 each for fiscal years 2008 and 2009 and \$500,000 each for fiscal years 2010 through 2012. In 2008, EPA augmented these funds with appropriated funds and awarded approximately \$1 million in grants to fund five projects that use Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approaches to reduce pesticide risk with the funds to be spent over a two year period. In FY 2009, EPA augmented PRIA 2 funds with other EPA funds to award approximately \$1.3 million in grants, funding six projects. Partnership grant funds were also augmented in FY 2010 with Advanced Monitoring Initiative funds from EPA's Office of the Science Advisor to fund a total of five projects. In FY 2011, PRIA 2 funds supported three IPM grants totaling approximately \$500,000.
