

Tip for Grown-ups:

Teach your children that pesticides are poisons, something they should never touch or eat. Pesticides are only for grown-ups to use. Lock up all household, lawn, and garden chemicals. Store them in original containers with labels. Remove children, pets, and their toys from any area where pesticides are being applied, indoors or out.
