DEAR Director,

Inmates housed at Easterday Correctional Facility, in Barber County, ALABAMA are subject to:

1. Compost pollution;
2. Human waste pollution in segregation for reasons of toilets in cells flush 1 or 2 times per hour; sewage backed up;
3. Water inmates bath in, Drink use to heat or prepare food with, "if thrown on the grass it kills it and turns it brown."

The municipal entity responsible for the water or otherwise wastewater treatment has no control, care or concern for inmates lives and or health.
